

With ECOM Foundation's support, Educate! has been able to offer an experiencebased model to secondary school students in six schools in the Kapchorwa district of Uganda, comprised of entrepreneurship and leadership training, mentorship, and experience starting an enterprise. This has led to the formation of six successful business clubs; the launch of profitable businesses including soap-making, beekeeping, and farming.

Uganda has the world's youngest population, and with the highest youth unemployment rate at 83%, 90% of Ugandan youth are destined to work in the informal sector. The Educate! program addresses these statistics.
