Educate! on Al Jazeera English

Educate! will be featured in Al Jazeera English's televised documentary series, <u>Rebel Education</u>, as one of six institutions across the globe that is breaking the mold and creating a radically new vision for 21st century education. Educate! currently works in more than 350 schools in Uganda, with another 100 lined up in the near future. Its vision for 2024 is to measurably impact one million students, and reach four million students more broadly, across Africa each year.

The film follows a mentor and the "scholars" as they set up a new business in the school. We also track the students as they juggle their studies, home life, and the pressure of making the business successful. Funds are limited and the only money they will have to invest will come from their profits. But the business skills they learn through real-world projects will prepare them for a future in which they will be able to support their families and play a leading role in their communities.
